## Footnotes

*(all citations are to Division 20 of the Health and Safety Code (HSC); or Division 4.5 of Title 22 of the California Code of Regulations (22 CCR))*

- <sup>1</sup> Handles hazardous materials at or above 55 gallons for liquids, 500 pounds for solids, or 200 cubic feet for compressed gases. *[HSC Chapter 6.95, Article 1]*
- <sup>2</sup> Generates 100 kg (220 pounds) or less of hazardous waste per month, excluding universal waste. *(This permit category draws from the Code of Federal Regulations definition and is only intended to be applied as a permit fee category. It does not imply generator status. California regulations only distinguish generators as SQG or LQG.) [40 CFR §262.14]*
- <sup>3</sup> Generates less than 1,000 kg (2,200 pounds) of hazardous waste per month, excluding universal waste, and/or 1 kg or less of acutely or extremely hazardous waste per month. *[HSC Chapter 6.5; 22 CCR Chapter 11 §66262.34]*
- <sup>4</sup> Generates 1,000 kg or more of hazardous waste per month, excluding universal waste, and/or more than 1 kg of acutely or extremely hazardous waste per month. *[HSC Chapter 6.5; 22 CCR Chapter 11 §66262.34]*
- <sup>5</sup> Generates in any single calendar month 1,000 kg or more of RCRA (federally-regulated) hazardous waste, or generate in any single calendar month, or accumulate at any time, 1 kg of RCRA acutely hazardous waste; or generate or accumulate at any time more than 100 kg of spill cleanup materials contaminated with RCRA acute hazardous waste. *[HSC Chapter 6.5; 22 CCR Chapter 10 §66260.10, 22 CCR Chapter 11]*
- <sup>6</sup> Exceeds a total storage capacity of 1,320 gallons of petroleum products (new or used) in 55 gallon or greater aboveground tanks or containers. *[HSC Chapter 6.67]*
- <sup>7</sup> Has one or more Tanks In Underground Areas (TIUGAs)*[HSC Chapter 6.67]*
- <sup>8</sup> Stores onsite regulated substances greater than the threshold quantities established by the California Accidental Release Prevention Program (CalARP). *[HSC Chapter 6.95, Article 2]*
