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WATER QUALITY EMERGENCY NOTIFICATION PLAN

The California Health and Safety Code, Section 4029, requires all water utilities to have an **Emergency Notification Plan**. This plan is to be implemented whenever Tulare County Environmental Health Services Division determines that your water supply fails to meet water quality standards and poses an imminent danger to the health of the water users. It is recommended that this same plan be used for water outages and rationing resulting from natural or man-made disasters.
