A tier 1 commercial edible food generator means a commercial, edible food generator that is one of the following:

- A. Supermarket*.
- B. Grocery store with a total facility size equal to or greater than 10,000 square feet.
- C. Food service provider.
- D. Wholesale Food vendor.

* Supermarket is a full-line, self-service retail store with gross annual sales of two million dollars, or more, and sells a line of dry grocery, canned goods, or nonfood items and some perishable items.

A Tier two commercial edible food generator means a commercial edible food generator that is one of the following:

- A. Restaurant with 250 or more seats, or a total facility size equal to or greater than 5,000 square feet.
- B. Hotel with an on-site food facility and 200 or more rooms.
- C. Health facility with an on-site food facility and 100 or more beds.
- D. Large venue.
- E. Large event.
- F. A state agency with a cafeteria with 250 or more seats or a total cafeteria facility size equal to or greater than 5,000 square feet.
- G. A local education agency with an on-site food facility.

Section 18991.4. Recordkeeping Requirements for Commercial Edible Food Generators

(1) Operator has provided a copy of **current** contract(s) or written agreement(s) between the commercial edible food generator and a food recovery service or organization. **(Attach copy of agreement(s) to this inspection form)**

(2) Operator has shown a record of the following for each food recovery organization or service that the commercial edible food generator has a contract or written agreement with pursuant to Section 18991.3(b):

- A. The name, address and contact information of the service or organization.
- B. The types of food that will be collected by or self-hauled to the service or organization.
- C. The established frequency that food will be collected or self-hauled.
- D. The quantity of food collected or self-hauled to a service or organization for food recovery. The quantity shall be measured in **pounds** recovered per month
